Eligibility to Host

In order to be eligible to apply to host a meeting, a member of Women Who Wine of the Flathead (WWWF) must meet the following criteria:

- Payment of \$360 (either up front or commitment and up to date on payments)
- A minimum of 6 months of membership in WWWF
- Attendance at minimum of 6 meetings in the past year
- Commitment to attend the banquet (if at all possible) and coordinate getting the nonprofit to also attend the banquet.
- At least 1 year has passed since the last time hosting a meeting

These are the minimum criteria to complete an application to host. There may still be a wait before the member's nonprofit is selected and a month is assigned.

The Advisory Committee reviews these applications quarterly.
